Commissioner Champagne moved to declare the subject property as surplus and to be sold. Commissioner Gamble seconded the motion. The motion carried Consider Approval to Attend Golden Triangle Days

Mr. Sims stated that 2025 Golden Triangle Days will be held in Austin, Texas, March 3 - 5, 2025. Mr. Sims stated that he was informed by Texas Senate staffers and Texas House of Representative staffers that the \$230 million to be used for GCPD and the Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Project was not included in the state budget presented for consideration. This turn of events will require the District to lobby for 26/27 funding. It is also unclear whether the bill to change Chapter 49 of the Texas Water Code will be

presented to the Senate and House of Representative for consideration. This bill would enable the District to hold elections during odd years in November which would ensure that the District will always be able to partner with the County elections, saving the District over a hundred thousand dollars. Commissioner Champagne moved that any Commissioner and/or staff be authorized to attend. Commissioner Gamble seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Consider Approval to attend National Waterways Conference

Mr. Sims stated that the National Waterways 2025 Legislative Summit will be held in Washington, D.C. March 10 - 12, 2025. Commissioner Gamble moved that any Commissioner and/or staff be authorized to attend. Commissioner Vincent seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Consider Approval to Attend TWA (Formerly TWCA) 2025 Annual Convention

Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Summary

Once funding is omitted from the budget it is difficult to get it reinstated. Mr. Sims stated that he is going to request to speak at the budget hearing scheduled for next week.
