Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Summary

Mr. Sims informed the board that the United States Army Corps of Engineers ("USACE") held Cost Schedule Risk Analysis Meetings last week to determine what could happen that would cause scheduling delays and increase project costs. USACE is in the process of updating their P2 schedule, which is the overall project schedule. Both will be provided to the District upon completion.

Mr. Sims also informed the board that USACE was questioning if the Orange County Project was going to continue. The Orange County project was approved by Congress as part of the Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Project. Mr. Sims is working to ensure that the District's project does not become collateral damage. USACE is trying to prevent this but does not yet have answers. Commissioner Champagne stated that the District should take the stance that the District has an existing levee system. He stated that the District has received funding from the state for the improvement of the District's levee per USACE recommendation, while Orange County's levee is a new construction. Mr. Sims agreed but the concern is that the Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay project was passed by Congress as one single project and if one part of the project is discontinued, USACE will need to figure out how to separate the District's project from the Orange County Project.

Manager Reports

Mr. Sims stated that he would be going to Austin this week to attend a hearing on the District's proposed election bill. This bill would ensure that the District will always be able to partner with Jefferson County for its elections. The cost to run a stand alone election is very expensive.

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Mr. Sims stated that the renewal of Ron Lewis's Consulting contract was received.

Based on discussions with the board in January 2025, a new lobbyist was contracted for

the State of Texas affairs. Unless otherwise informed, Mr. Sims stated that he would be

graciously declining to renew Mr. Lewis's contract.

Mr. Sims informed the board that the District has received its preliminary appraisal

from Jefferson Central Appraisal District, before taxpayer protests. He noted an increase

of \$222,747,000 but this increase will not be final until June or July. This change could be

attributed to the rise in property values, business values, and inventory in businesses.
