The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. by Chairman Beaumont after ascertaining that the Notice of Meeting had been posted in accordance with the law. Commissioner Champagne gave the invocation.

Minutes of Meeting No. 2441 and 2442

The Minutes of Meeting No. 2441 and 2442 were approved as read.

Open Bids and Consider Award of Bid for Purchase of Diesel Engines and Reduction Gears for Star Lake and Rodair Pump Stations

Mr. Allen Sims stated that one bid was received. One addendum item was added to the bid packet due to current tariffs. Mr. Sims explained that Addendum One added a line item that included a \$30,000 tariff allowance. If the tariff is higher than \$30,000 at the time of purchase, a change order will be submitted for an increase. If the tariff is lower than \$30,000 at the time of purchase, a change order will be submitted to return the remainder. Commissioner Champagne motioned to award the bid to Cummins Sales and Services for Five Diesel Engines and Five Reduction Gears for Star Lake and Rodair Pump Station in the amount of \$697,750.00. Commissioner Vincent seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. Allen Sims submitted the Certificate of Construction Completion for the Discharge Pipe Support Replacement for West Port Arthur Road Pump Station (Pump Station #3) Project. Mr. Sims stated that all work has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications. Elite Contractors and Equipment Ltd. has acknowledged that they are responsible for repairing, replacing, and making good on any faulty workmanship and/or materials discovered in the work within a period of 12 months from the date of completion of the project. Commissioner Vincent motioned to approve the

Certificate of Construction Completion relating to the Discharge Pipe Support Replacement for West Port Arthur Road Pump Station (Pump Station #3) Project.

Commissioner Gamble seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Consider 2nd and Final Pay Request to Elite Contractors and Equipment, Ltd for the Discharge Pipe Support Replacement for West Port Arthur Road Pump Station (Pump Station #3)

Mr. Allen Sims presented the second and final Pay Request from Elite Contractors and Equipment LTD for approval. The invoice from Elite Contractors and Equipment LTD submitted for payment is for the Replacement of Discharge Pipe Support Replacement for the West Port Arthur Road Pump Station (Pump Station #3) in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$121,500.00) Dollars. Commissioner Vincent moved to approve the Pay Request from Elite Contractors and Equipment LTD for the Replacement of Discharge Pipe Support Replacement for the West Port Arthur Road Pump Station (Pump Station #3) in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$121,500.00) Dollars. Commissioner Champagne seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Consider Pay Request No. 5 to Triangle Civil Services for Sanitary Sewer Line Relocation at West Port Acres Wastewater Treatment Plant

A recommendation letter was submitted by Keith Zotzky, with Arceneaux, Wilson & Cole LLC for Pay Request No. 5 to Triangle Civil Services for work performed from April 1, 2025, to April 30, 2025, in the amount of Ninety-Three Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Nine and 24/100 (\$93,669.24) Dollars. Mr. Zotzky stated that 99% of the work has been completed using 84% of the contract's working days. Line items being billed on this pay request are 139 linear feet of 36" sanitary sewer line is being replaced with 48" sanitary sewer line associated with a trench safety system, dewatering, and remove and replace

3 manholes. The project schedule completion date is June 18, 2025. Since this pay request was submitted a final walk through was completed and a punch list was created. The system is off bypass, and everything is functioning as designed. Commissioner Champagne moved to approve Pay Request No. 5 to Triangle Civil Services for items completed from April 1, 2025, to April 30, 2025, in the amount of Ninety-Three Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Nine and 24/100 (\$93,669.24) Dollars. Commissioner Gamble seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Consider Approval of Interlocal Agreement with the City of Port Arthur to Spread Excess Dirt at the City of Port Arthur Landfill as a Result of the Groves Detention Pond Project

Mr. Sims stated the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Port Arthur to Spread Excess Dirt at the City of Port Arthur Landfill as a Result of the Groves Detention Pond Project was on City of Port Arthur's City Council Meeting's agenda today for consideration. As of 1:15 pm the City Council had not taken up the agenda item, therefore, he suggested that it be tabled until the City Council approves the proposed Interlocal Agreement. Commissioner Champagne made a motion to table the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Port Arthur to Spread Excess Dirt at the City of Port Arthur Landfill as a Result of the Groves Detention Pond Project. Commissioner Gamble seconded the motion. The motion carried.

<u>Consider Approval to Advertise for Bids for Construction of A3A Detention Pond and Groves Detention Pond</u>

Mr. Sims requested approval to Advertise for Bids for the Construction of A3A Detention Pond and Groves Detention Pond. Commissioner Champagne moved to approve the request to Advertise for the Construction of A3A Detention Pond and Groves Detention Pond. Commissioner Vincent seconded the motion. The motion carried.

<u>Consider Resolution to Approve Donation of Land to Texas Department of Transportation</u> in relation to Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay <u>Project</u>

Consider Resolution No. 535 Donating Land to the Texas Department of Transportation in relation to the Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Project. Mr. Sims stated that the District purchased the property for \$7,500. Commissioner Gamble moved to approve Resolution No. 535 authorizing the Donation of Real Property to the Texas Department of Transportation as it Relates to Property needed for the expansion and realignment of FM 365 in Jefferson County, Texas. Commissioner Champagne seconded the motion. The motion carried. A copy of Resolution No. 535 is attached hereto and made a part of these minutes.

Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Summary

Mr. Allen Sims stated that he and Mr. Toby Davis attended a meeting with USACE in Dallas related to the Orange County portion of the Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Project. The main discussion revolved around cancelling the Orange County portion of the Project. When Congress approved this project it included the District, Brazoria County and Orange County as a whole under one project. Brazoria County opted out of the project. The biggest concern is that if USACE cancels the Orange County portion of the project, the District's project will be cancelled as well. The opinion of the USACE ranking officials that the Orange Project is within the Chief's discretionary authority. GCPD is meeting with General Kelly today regarding his position on this opinion. The District was advised that the Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Project has \$3.9 billion in funding. It is first come first serve, meaning if the District completes its projects first the District will receive the funding. The Colonel stated that if the District can get its projects into construction and the General decides not to execute his authority, the District's projects

will not be stopped. Contract 4 is in construction. The Executive Governance Meeting with USACE will be held at the District Thursday, May 29, 2025.

Manager Reports

Mr. Allen Sims presented the financial statements prepared by FMW, P.C. for the period ending April 30, 2025, and gave a collateral securities report as of April 30, 2025.

Mr. Sims stated that an agreement with ISTC has been finalized. Should the District not be able to utilize its facility during a hurricane event the ISTC facility will be available.






