Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Summary

Mr. Allen Sims reported that a meeting was recently held regarding Contract 4 to address and resolve design concerns from both parties. He noted that the Post Authorization Change Report (PACR) is still under development. Byron Williams, Deputy District Engineer for Programs and Project Management, and Mr. Hibner, top civilian at Division in Dallas are scheduled to meet to discuss options for securing additional funding without having to proceed through the Change Control Board.

Mr. Sims further stated that approximately 30 citizens attended the public meeting held on November 20, 2025, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Port Arthur regarding Contract 4. Another public meeting will be scheduled as the project approaches the construction phase.

Mrs. Gloston secured the District an overpayment refund of \$11,451, along with \$916 in interest, for a total reimbursement of \$12,367.00.
