

Hazard Mitigation Plan Public Meeting on August 24, 2016

Orange County will hold a public meeting on Wednesday, August 24th to gather public input for the Hazard Mitigation Plan Updates for the Counties of Orange, Hardin, and Jefferson and the South East Texas Regional Planning Commission. The meeting is at 5:30 p.m. at the Orange County Expo Center; 11475 FM 1442, Orange 77630-5227. The public is invited and encouraged to attend the meeting.

The purpose of the public meeting is to provide a project overview from H₂O Partners, Inc., consultant to the project, and solicit information from citizens. Public input will help the project team to identify and analyze potential hazards affecting residents and recommend possible actions to reduce their impact.
