

NOTICE OF TAX ABATEMENT CONSIDERATION

NOTICE is hereby given that the Jefferson County Drainage District No. 7 will consider approving a Tax Abatement Agreement for Emerald Biofuels at its Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners on Tuesday, February 16, 2021, at 2:00 p.m., at its office at 4149 Twin City Highway, Suite 300, Port Arthur, Texas 77642.

Emerald Biofuels is the Applicant for the Tax Abatement Agreement and also the Owner of various parcels of land located within the Emerald Biofuels Reinvestment Zone in Port Arthur, Texas. The project will involve construction of a new Coker and Sulfur Unit and related improvements ("the proposed Project"). The estimated cost of the proposed Project is in excess of \$330 million. The Project upon its completion will maintain a level of not less than 40 new full-time jobs consisting of both permanent direct employee jobs and permanent contractor jobs.


