Complaint — TWC (texas.gov)

The Civil Rights Division conducts neutral investigations and gathers information to determine if discrimination has occurred under the Texas Fair Housing Act and rules.

These are a few of the most common housing discrimination allegations:

• The landlord would not rent to me because I have a child.

- The bank would not give me a home loan because I was pregnant.
- The property manager refused to assign me a parking space close to my apartment even though I am mobility-impaired.

Complaint Requirements

To submit a housing discrimination complaint to TWC, all of these requirements must be met:

- The property must be within the state of Texas.
- The property owner, in most cases, must have more than three properties.
- The date of discrimination must have occurred within the last 365 calendar days before the date you are submitting the complaint.
- Your complaint must specify one or more of the following types of housing discrimination: race, color, national origin, religion, sex, disability or familial status.
- Your complaint must identify the housing harm.

How to Submit a Complaint

You must submit your complaint within one year (365 calendar days) from the date of the discrimination. You can submit a housing discrimination. The preferred method for submitting a housing discrimination complaint form is through our <u>Housing Discrimination Inquiry Form</u>.

Complaints cannot be provided over the telephone.
