

NOTICE OF TAX ABATEMENT CONSIDERATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Jefferson County Drainage District No. 7 will consider approving a Tax Abatement Agreement for Linde, Inc. at its Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners on Tuesday, June 4, 2024, at 2:00 p.m. at its office at 3400 Hwy 73, Port Arthur, Texas.

Linde, Inc. is the Applicant for a Tax Abatement Agreement and possesses interests in taxable real property located within Jefferson County, Texas. The project will involve the construction and operation of a trucking terminal to facilitate the receipt and distribution of helium assets stored in an underground cavern developed, owned, and operated by Golden Triangle Storage (“the project”). The estimated cost of the Project is \$115 million. The Project upon its completion will maintain a level of not less than 10 new full-time jobs consisting of both permanent direct employee jobs and permanent contractor jobs.
